FINLAND**State Awards and Prizes**

State Awards are granted by the national arts councils - the expert bodies of the Arts Promotion Centre Finland - to an artist or a group of two or more artists in recognition of a work or performance in a specific art form. The work or performance must date back no more than three years and be of especially high artistic merit. State Awards can also be given to artists for their long-term valuable contribution to a specific art form. In addition, state prizes can be awarded to art associations or other communities.

The Ministry of Education and Culture has presented the State Award for Foreign Translators since 1975 on the basis of a recommendation by FILI - Finnish Literature Exchange. Ministry of Education and culture awards several sectors (incl. cinema, visual arts, illustrations, media art, photographic art), individual artists and groups with State prizes.
